ELIGIBILITY:

The RBC Canadian Open qualifying competition is open to:

1. Members in good standing of the CPGA or other PGA affiliates
2. Amateur golfers (current Handicap Factor not to exceed 0) who are members of clubs belonging to the Golf Canada or clubs in other countries which are in good standing with their respective associations
3. Other golf professionals

QUALIFYING FORMAT:

Golf Canada will conduct an 18-hole stroke play competition, with a minimum of 4 qualifying spots directly into the 2010 RBC Canadian Open to be contested at St. Georges Golf & Country Club, July 19-25, 2010.

Golf Canada reserves the right to increase the size of the field and the number of qualifying spots available.

ENTRY FEE/DEADLINE PROCEDURE:

- Entry fee of \$250 including GST (Canadian Funds) or \$250 U.S. Funds is payable by credit card and must accompany the official entry form.
- The first 156 entries received on or before 5:00 p.m. on July 14, 2010 will be accepted. The field will be posted <http://rcga.bluegolf.com/bluegolf/rcga10/event/rcga109/index.htm>, and players will be notified by email of their status.
- **Entry fees will not be refunded after entry closing date.** Late entries will not be accepted.
- All entries are subject to the approval of Golf Canada. Golf Canada will acknowledge each entry.
- Starting times will be established by Golf Canada and will be listed on the web site <http://rcga.bluegolf.com/bluegolf/rcga10/event/rcga109/index.htm>

PERFORMANCE IN QUALIFYING

If a player fails to return a score within 10 strokes of the final qualifying score, an entry filed by him for a future RBC Canadian Open Championship Qualifier(s) may be declined, unless the player can document that he is capable of competing at the national championship level. **2009 RBC Canadian Open Qualifier scores will be taken into account for the 2010 RBC Canadian Open Qualifier field.** Those posting a score higher than 10 strokes in 2009 will not be entered into the field until after the closing date (July 14, 2010) at which time if playing spots are available preference will be given to the best finishers in the 2009 RBC Canadian Open Qualifier.
