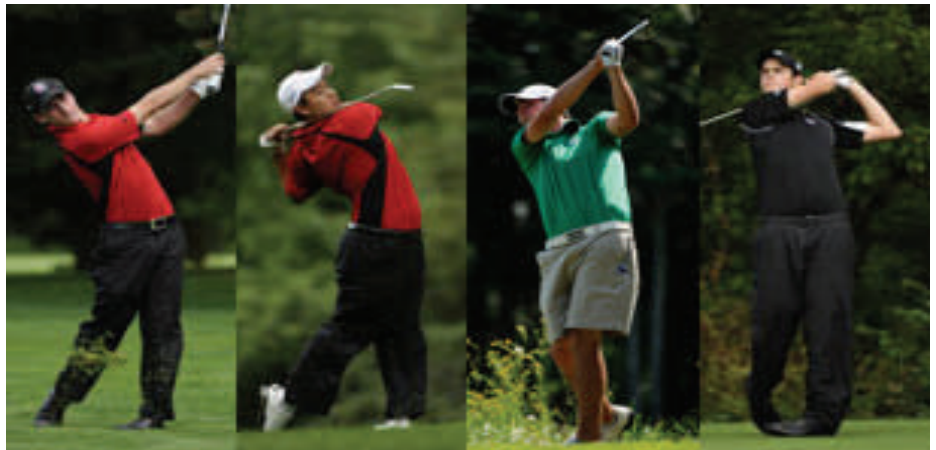

New Additions to Field for 2010 RBC Canadian Open

Golf Canada, in partnership with RBC, announced June 11th that Team Canada's Nick Taylor of Abbotsford, B.C. and Eugene Wong of North Vancouver, B.C., as well as former Team Canada member, Matt Hill of Bright's Grove, Ont., who recently turned professional, have received exemptions into the 2010 RBC Canadian Open taking place July 19-25 at St. George's Golf and Country Club in Toronto.

The trio will join Team Canada's Cam Burke of New Hamburg, Ont. who earned his RBC Canadian Open exemption after winning the 2009 Canadian Men's Amateur Championship title. Burke's Canadian Men's Amateur victory was his second in as many years at the prestigious championship.



"These talented players have showcased their pedigree and are very deserving of these exemptions," said Golf Canada Executive Director and CEO, Scott Simmons. "They are among the best young golfers in the world and we are certain to see exciting play from them as they compete with the PGA TOUR's biggest and best names at St. George's in July."

Please note: Parking at Richview Collegiate Institute is very limited. We strongly recommend that all volunteers carpool or take public transportation to and from their orientation.

In Case You Cannot Make Your Orientation...

1. Inform your committee chair that you will not be able to attend. (Do not attend an orientation other than your own).
2. Visit the Volunteer Centre at St. George's Golf and Country Club on **Saturday, July 17th between 10am - 4pm** to pick up your volunteer package. There will not be any parking available at the club. Parking will be available (on this day only) at St. George's Junior School at 70 Princess Anne Crescent. After parking, volunteers will walk the short distance to the Volunteer Centre.
3. If you will not arrive in town before July 17th please use your volunteer newsletter as 'one-time' entry to the volunteer parking lot (location TBA) Monday, July 19th to Wednesday, July 21st during championship week. The volunteer shuttle will then take you directly to the volunteer drop point at St. George's Junior School where you will be able to pick up your volunteer package from the volunteer services committee, before going through admissions.
